

Classroom Expectations

BEGINNING OF CLASS:

1. **Be in your assigned seat with ALL your class materials when the Tardy Bell rings.**

CLASS MATERIALS:

- A. **Your Textbook**
 - B. **A 3-Ring Binder w/ Loose Leaf Paper** (Notes can be taken on any type of paper **BUT** All Homework & Labwork MUST be done on loose leaf paper, (Points may be deducted on work turned with RAGGED EDGES!))
 - C. **A Pen and Pencil** that have a fine point and are a dark color: NO reds, yellows, oranges, light greens, etc. and no magic markers. (If I can't read it, it'll be counted wrong!)
 - D. **A Calculator** that can handle scientific notation and trigonometric functions. We will use this almost daily. A graphing/programmable calculator can be used for all Homework & Lab work but will NOT BE ALLOWED ON TESTS! (Note: Any student who has ONLY a graphing/programmable calculator will be given a non-programmable calculator to use on tests.)
2. **Hold all questions until after roll is checked, recorded, and the absences are posted.**
 3. **Food, candy, gum, and drinks are NOT permitted in the classroom during LAB Activities. During non-LAB classes, these will be permitted AS LONG AS students show responsibility and class is NOT disrupted (This includes noise of opening/throwing away packaging!)**
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DURING CLASS:

4. **Remain in your assigned seat and always raise your hand & wait to be called upon before leaving your seat for any reason.**
 5. **Be respectful to each other by remaining quiet when class instruction or course information is being given.**
 6. **When you have questions, raise your hand and quietly wait to be called upon.**
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AT THE END OF CLASS:

7. **IF I am finished giving class instructions & course information, at 5 minutes before the end of the period you may stop working and put your things away in your book bag.**
 8. **Remain in your assigned seat until the bell rings.**
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Violation of ANY of these policies can result in but not be limited to LOSS of daily Participation Points, loss of Food/Drink in the Classroom privilege, and/or 1 HOUR of classroom DETENTION.

RESTROOMS:

9. You may have 4 restroom passes per Semester. Your 5th, 6th, etc., visits will cost you half of your daily Participation Points UNLESS you have a documented (through our school office) medical condition requiring unlimited restroom usage. Only 1 student at a time will be allowed to leave the room for a restroom visit.
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MAKE-UP WORK:

10. For all EXCUSED ABSENCES:

- * Previously assigned work due on a day you miss IS DUE THE DAY YOU RETURN without penalty!
- * A previously scheduled test on a day you miss will be made up THE DAY YOU RETURN without penalty!
- * You will have 1 day per day missed to make up assignments made during your absence without penalty.

11. For all UN-EXCUSED ABSENCES:

- * Previously assigned work due on a day you miss IS DUE THE DAY YOU RETURN & the most you can make on it is 1/2 credit.
- * A previously scheduled test on a day you miss will be made up THE DAY YOU RETURN & the highest you can make is 50%.
- * You will have 1 day per day missed to make up assignments made during your absence without an extra late penalty on top of the 1/2 credit penalty for the Un-Excused Absence.

12. Due to the unique nature of all LAB activities, there will be NO Make-Up Labs. Labs missed during EXCUSED absences will not count for or against you. For Labs missed during UN-EXCUSED absences, you will be required to write a 2 page, single spaced, paper on a topic assigned by me that will be due 3 days from when it was assigned in order to receive up to 1/2 credit for the missed Lab. You will still be responsible for material missed in Lab. You will be given needed information to study missed material for test purposes but it is up to you to use these resources to adequately prepare for tests.

13. Make-up work is NOT to be done at school in place of current assignments once you return to class. It should be done at home or done AFTER all current in-class assignments are complete.
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LATE WORK:

14. Any assignment turned in AFTER its due date BUT BEFORE I hand it back to go over in class, will be considered LATE and will receive a 20% point deduction for being late.
15. Any assignment not turned in by the time I hand it back and go over it in class will be graded "0"/"F".
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WORK FROM OTHER CLASSES:

17. You may NOT work on assignments from other classes in this class unless you can show me your COMPLETED WORK, BOTH CURRENT and MAKE UP ASSIGNMENTS, for this class FIRST. I will take and keep any other classes work if I see you working on it without having finished your work in this class first.
